The Supreme Court of the Virgin Islands wishes to advise the general public and members of the Virgin Islands Bar that effective October 3, 2011, the Supreme Court will begin collection on both islands of all of its fees previously collected by the Superior Court of the Virgin Islands on behalf of the Supreme Court.

The Court fees to be collected shall include, but are not limited to:

- Filing and Docketing of Appeal
- Filing of an Application for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission to the Virgin Islands Bar
- Filing of an Application for Regular Admission to the Virgin Islands Bar
- Attorneys' Certificate of Good Standing
- Copying of Documents
- Certified Copies of Any Record
- Search of the Record
- Closed-case Retrieval/Search

The approved methods of payments include, cash, personal and business checks, money orders, Visa, MasterCard and Discover Credit Cards. Please note that all checks and money orders should be made payable to the "Government of the Virgin Islands".

The Superior Court's assistance in the prior collection and processing of the fees on behalf of the Supreme Court was greatly appreciated.
